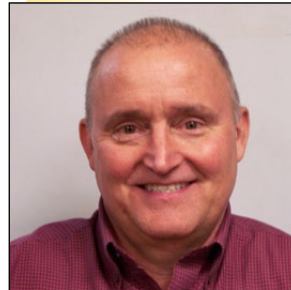

WEIGHT MANAGEMENT: FILL UP ON FIBER

High-fiber foods fill you up, but they don't fill you out because they are usually low in calories. Both men and women should try and consume 20-35 grams of fiber daily. You can get fiber from fruits and vegetables; dried peas, lentils, and beans; whole grains, such as brown rice and barley; and whole-grain breads and cereals.



High Fiber Tips:

- Choose fruit rather than juice.
- Use meat as a side rather than your main dish.
- Look for breads with at least 2 grams of fiber per slice. Also look for whole grain flour as the first ingredient.
- Leave skins on potatoes, veggies, and fruits when possible.
- Add crushed grain cereal, ground flaxseed, or wheat bran to meatloaf, baked goods, and casseroles.
- Slowly add more fiber to your diet. And, drink more fluids.
